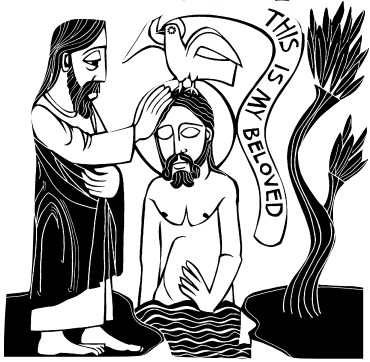

- After the weekend Masses, take some of the **poinsettias** home with you. After the Sunday Mass, we will begin to take down trees, wreaths, banners, etc. Anyone may stay to help. It will not take too long.
- If you have any palms from previous Palms Sundays, please bring them to church to be burned and used for Ash Wednesday.
- In the coming weeks, Archbishop Coakley will be offering some guidance and updates about the various liturgical rites that will take place in February. In light of the pandemic, there will be some changes pertaining to the Blessing of Throats on the Feast of Saint Blase (February 3), distributing ashes on Ash Wednesday (February 17), and the Rite of Election on the First Sunday of Lent (February 21).
- Bring your prayer candle(s) for a special blessing on Sunday, January 31.

# COVID-19 Vaccination Appointment

Any person 65 or older are encouraged to pre-register online for the vaccine. Use the following link to register for Oklahoma’s Vaccine Scheduler Portal:

Pre-registration allows anyone in Oklahoma to register their contact information with the Oklahoma State Department of Health and indicate that they would like to be notified when the vaccine is available to them.

After you enter your information, if you’re eligible to receive the vaccine, you will receive an email with instructions on how to schedule your appointment.

Please note that eligibility does not guarantee an appointment will be available to you. Appointment availability is solely dependent on vaccine supply in each county.

Vaccinations are available by **appointment only, no walk-ins.** Vaccination Centers in Ada are at the Agriplex (1701 N Broadway Ave) and the Pontotoc County Health Dept. (2330 Arlington St., phone 580-332-2011).

If anyone is unable to register online they can call Julie at the Parish Office for assistance.
